

Special Event Breakdowns

- Vehicle Customizer

- In state and out of state motor vehicle customizers can display cars, trucks, and RV's they build or modify at a special event in South Dakota. No sales allowed.
 - Permit required with cost

Referenced statute 32-6B-5.6

- Vehicles

- Licensed South Dakota dealers may sell or display new and used vehicles at an event if it is held within the county they are licensed in.
 - No permit required
- Licensed South Dakota dealers may sell and display at a public auction if the vehicle is 20 years old or older.
 - No permit required
- Out of state licensed dealers may sell a vehicle that is at least 20 years old at a public auction on consignment in South Dakota.
 - Permit required with cost
- Licensed South Dakota dealers cannot display new vehicles outside of their county.
- Licensed South Dakota dealers cannot display used vehicles outside of their county unless at an auction and the vehicle is at least 20 years old.

- Heavy Trucks/Truck Tractors

- Licensed South Dakota dealers may sell or display outside of their county.
 - No permit required

- Off-Road units

- A licensed South Dakota dealer can go to an event outside of the county if
 - 1) Even does not exceed 7 days.
 - 2) The dealer has a franchise for the off-road vehicle.
 - 3) No dealer in the county where the event is in has a franchise for the off-road unit.Permit must be applied for at least 20 days before the event.
 - Permit required with no cost
- A manufacturer can bring new off-road units to an event for display only
 - Permit required with cost
- An out-of-state dealer can sell or display new off-road vehicles only if the make is not currently franchised in South Dakota.
 - Permit required with cost
- An out of state dealer can display or sell used off road vehicle if the unit is 2 model years old and has at least 2,500 on the odometer
 - Permit required with cost

Statute Referenced 32-6B-89

- Trailers

- A licensed South Dakota may display and sell new & used at any special event in South Dakota.
 - No permit required
- A trailer manufacturer can display only at an event. NO SALES.
 - Permit required with cost
- Out-of-state licensed trailer dealers can display and sell used trailers at a special event.
 - Permit required with cost
- Out-of-state licensed trailer dealer can display only new trailers if there is no like franchised dealer in the state or if they have permission from *each* dealer of the same make.
 - Permit required with cost

Referenced statutes 32-6B-5.3, 32-6B-5.5

- Motorcycles

- A licensed South Dakota dealer may display new motorcycles out of county only if it is a manufactured special event in an adjoining county where no other like franchised dealers are.
 - No permit required
- A licensed South Dakota dealer may display and sell used motorcycles outside of their county only if they are at least 2 model years old and have at least 2,500 on the odometer.
 - Permit required with cost
- Out-of-state license dealers may sell motorcycles at an event. New motorcycles are allowed if there is no other franchised dealer in the state. Used are allowed if the unit is at least two model years old, and has at least 2,500 miles on the odometer. They must provide proof they are licensed in another state and have no outstanding dealer violations.
 - Permit required with cost
- Out-of-state licensed dealers may sell a motorcycle that is at least 30 years old at a public auction on consignment.
 - Permit required with cost.
- Manufacturers can bring new to display only at a special event.
 - Permit required with cost
- A person who is sponsoring an event for displaying customized motorcycle built for the event can do so.

- Snowmobiles
 - Snowmobile dealers from in state and out of state can go to any event in South Dakota.
 - No permit needed

- Boats
 - Licensed South Dakota dealers may display and sell boats and boat trailers at an event.
 - No permit needed
 - Out of state boat dealer may display of sell boats/trailers at an event if the event lasts 2 or more days. Event must be organized and sponsored with no less than 3 licensed dealers displaying boats.

Permit must be applied for at least 5 days before event.

 - Permit needed
